Briefing on Underground Movement "Justice for Humans" (J4H) Opposing Quasars

Introduction:

The "Justice for Humans" (J4H) is an underground movement that has gained momentum in recent years. This group opposes the presence and actions of Quasars within society. This briefing provides an overview of J4H, its goals, methods, and potential implications.

Background:

J4H was founded in response to the growing presence of superpowered individuals, commonly known as Quasars, in various cities around the world. While Quasars are often celebrated for their crime-fighting efforts, J4H believes that they pose a significant threat to humanity. Their primary concerns include:

- Civil Liberties: J4H argues that Quasars' actions often infringe on the civil liberties of ordinary citizens. They claim that these individuals operate without oversight and can cause unintended harm while pursuing criminals.

- Accountability: The group aims to raise public awareness about the activities of Quasars and the consequences of Quasar activities, often through release of media content on difficult to track social and media sharing applications.
- Community Empowerment: J4H seeks to empower ordinary citizens to take control of their own safety and well-being, rather than relying on Quasars. They endorse carrying weapons, arguing that groups of armed citizens can disable Quasars and that the increase in weapon firepower brought by Quasars justifies 'normal humans' arming themselves to avoid 'extinction through attrition'.

Methods:

- Propaganda: The group disseminates information through pamphlets, social media, and public events to educate the public about their concerns. They do this through an underground network and have so far thus managed to dissemble their true numbers or memberships.
- Direct Action: Some factions within J4H engage in direct action, which can include attacks on Quasars, false reports of Quasar acts, participation in EQUAL, NIQ, or Nequalilty Rights rallies, and through individual acts of civil disobedience.
- Legal Advocacy: J4H is known to support legal challenges against Quasars and push for legal reform in favor of increased accountability. J4H does have indirect public endorsers in the form of counsel that represents them in court.

Implications:

- Public Opinion: J4H's efforts may sway public opinion regarding the role of Quasars in society, potentially leading to increased scrutiny and accountability for these individuals.
- Conflict: Tensions between J4H and Quasars could escalate leading to confrontations and legal battles.
- Legal Reforms: Governments may consider implementing new laws and regulations to address the concerns raised by J4H, potentially reshaping the landscape of Quasar and Q-tech activities.
- Social Division: The movement could exacerbate the divide between those who support Quasars and those who view them with skepticism, leading to societal polarization.

In conclusion, "Justice for Humans" (J4H) is an underground movement that opposes Quasars, advocating for greater oversight, accountability, and community empowerment. Their efforts have the potential to influence public opinion and the legal landscape surrounding Quasars, but they also raise questions about the balance between individual freedoms and superpowered intervention.

They have not been linked to individual acts or subversion, considered a more mainline opposition. J4H has a limited membership and participation - with their relationship with local groups being dependent on the Quasar groups involved. They are most prominently involved in New York, Los Angeles, Dallas, and Houston in the United States. Outside of the United States, they have a pervasive, if not overt presence in the cities of Toronto, London, Jakarta, Hong Kong, Johannesburg, and Mexico City.
