**Subject:** Prevention and Capture of Criminals Intent on Attacking the Vittenhiem HOURGLASS Q-Tech Reactor

### Summary:

A coordinated effort by the Bundesnachrichtendienst (BND), in collaboration with the CIA and local law enforcement, successfully thwarted a planned attack on the Vittenhiem HOURGLASS Q-Tech Reactor. The operation led to the capture of key suspects, including Ivan Petrov, Lena Müller, Ahmed Al-Farsi, and several members of the Daremanov family. Enhanced security measures have been implemented at the reactor, addressing previous oversights.

## Key Individuals:

#### 1. Ivan Petrov

- Background: Ex-Russian military, known for expertise in explosives.
- Role: Responsible for procuring and deploying explosives intended to breach the reactor's physical security.
- Status: Captured in Prague during a coordinated operation.

## 2. Lena Müller

- Background: German national, highly skilled cyber specialist.
- Role: Tasked with developing and deploying a virus to disable the reactor's security systems.

### **Operation Overview.**

### 1. Intelligence Gathering:

- Initial intelligence indicated a coordinated plan to attack the Vittenhiem HOURGLASS Q-Tech Reactor.
- Surveillance identified key individuals involved in the plot.
- CIA operative William Chesney and an unknown informant provided critical information leading to the operation's success.

## 2. Coordinated Raids:

- Operations executed simultaneously in Berlin and Prague.
- Ivan Petrov apprehended in Prague with high-grade explosives.
- Lena Müller captured while attempting to deploy a cyber-attack on the reactor.
- o Ahmed Al-Farsi detained, and his financial operations were disrupted.

- Nationality: Russian
- Age: Various
- Skills: Organized crime, logistical support
- **Previous Affiliations:** Darremanov crime family
- Current Status: Multiple members in custody, pending legal proceedings.

#### Recommendations:

- 1. **Continued Surveillance**: Maintain monitoring of potential residual threats linked to the arrested individuals.
- 2. **Security Drills:** Conduct regular security drills at the Vittenhiem HOURGLASS Q-Tech Reactor to ensure preparedness.
- 3. **International Cooperation:** Strengthen international collaboration to track and dismantle transnational criminal networks.
- 4. **Public Communication**: Provide a controlled public statement to reassure the populace about the enhanced security measures at the reactor.
